



# Pied Piper Preschool Fundraising Information



We are a registered charity that relies on fundraising for a large portion of our operating budget. The fundraising commitment for this school year is \$180.00 per child enrolled. Parents have the option of participating in a variety of fundraising campaigns throughout the year, or by paying \$18/month in addition to their tuition fees. Families who choose to fundraise are responsible for making up any shortfall in their fundraising goal.

Fundraising commitment goals are divided into two terms. 1<sup>st</sup> term is September-December, 2<sup>nd</sup> term is January-June. Families who register to the program at a later date will have their fundraising goal adjusted according to their start date. A percentage of the total sales for your order is calculated towards your personal commitment goal. The percentage differs from each company we use for fundraising. Delivery charges are divided up by number of orders/items and then subtracted from the profit.

Information for fundraising events will be posted on the information board, in the school newsletter and attached to order forms. An envelope can be found in the class office located in the big classroom. Please write information needed on the attached form to help keep track of funds coming in/funds due.

Please write child's name, class and name of Fundraiser on memo of your cheque (*Zoe/2B – MacMillan's*)  
(No third party cheques please – Pied Piper Family only)
